Aussie superstar **Kylie Minogue** opened her first U.S. Tour, 'For You For Me' last week, playing to a sold out crowd at the **Pearl Concert Theater** at **Palms** in Las Vegas on Saturday night.

To be honest, like most of heterosexual Americans, we didn't know much about the songstress' music – just the major hits like "The Loco-Motion" and her 2002 hit, "Can't Get You Out of My Head," but were completely blown away by Minogue's hang-onto-your-seat production.

In a truly spectacular pop culture meets fashion collaboration, Miz Minogue wore several futuristic pieces from renowned designer, Jean Paul Gaultier's Autumn/Winter 2009/10 collection.
